

Fr. Enzo Del Brocco BIO:

Fr. Salvatore Enzo Del Brocco, CP (known just as Fr. Enzo) is of Italian descent born in the United States. After spending his childhood in Pittsburgh, PA he returned with his family to Italy. He became part of Passionist Order in 1991 and was ordained Priest in 1996. Fr. Enzo holds a Licentiate in Moral Theology, a Master's Degree in Human Resources, a Certification in Catholic Bioethics and is currently a PhD Student at Duquesne University in Healthcare Ethics. He has held various positions of leadership within the Passionist Order in Italy and is currently Vice-Provincial in the USA. Fr. Enzo has traveled to numerous countries and is fluent in six languages. He is a well-known preacher and has preached several retreats and given workshops in different countries. During his time as Provincial Superior in Italy, he worked with the community of S. Egidio in one of the peripheries of Naples, ministering to the poor, disabled and marginalized. He worked for five years in Haiti with the marginalized youth in the slums of Cite Soleil, as a hospital chaplain and providing pastoral outreach to the remote areas of the country affected by the Hurricane in 2016.
